

To: Cornell University Personnel Traveling to China, Russia, or Venezuela
From: Cornell University Export Control Office
RE: Controls on computers, phones, and software (PC Laptop)

Export control regulations now require that items listed on the Commerce Control List and carried with you under the TMP or BAG license exceptions, to China, Russia and Venezuela, must be reported to the government. Examples of items that must be reported include cell phones, cameras, laptops, computers and most software programs installed on computers. Note that this requirement applies regardless of the value of the item(s) or the fact that the item(s) will be abroad only temporarily. ***The required filing is an Electronic Export Information filed in the Automated Export System.***

To make the necessary filing, each individual traveler will need to know the export control classification number (ECCN) for all items being reported. The ECCNs for this device and associated software are listed below:

Please note that if additional programs are installed on this device, the traveler is responsible for obtaining the associated ECCN and reporting it appropriately.
