To provide participants with the knowledge and technical skills needed to be a **successful vascular fellow** or **senior vascular resident**.

- Two-day skills course intended for first-year vascular fellows and 3rd and 4th year integrated residents
- Topics covered will include: aortic aneurysms, cerebrovascular disease, peripheral arterial disease, venous disease and vascular imaging
